HEALTH FACTS SUPER-BASIC LIFE SKILLS

Let's look at some of our "automatic" functions and think of the effects of "proper" skills.

- How to breathe: Bring air down toward the belly, through the nose causing the diaphragm to contract and allowing the lungs more room to fill with oxygen.
- Move from a chair to a standing position without suing your arms. Use your legs and thighs to lift yourself up.
- Stand with your pelvis over your feet and 60% of your weight on your heels and 40% weight on the toe box area. Keep shoulders above pelvis. Try this while you wait in line.
- Walk by keeping balance with swinging arms opposite of the forward foot.
- Smiling can trigger chemical changes in our brain that can lead to a feeling of happiness. So, smile to make you feel happy.
