HEALTH FACTS

MISSOURI MEDICAID 2023

Missouri's Medicaid program (MOHealthNet) provides health insurance for low-income children and parents, adults aged 19-64, seniors aged 65+, pregnant women, and people with disabilities. It allows Missourians on this program to see a doctor when they are sick, get check-ups, buy medications, and go to the hospital.

Medicaid expansion in Missouri was implemented in October 2021. During 2022, the adult expansion group used only 4% of the total state Medicaid budget. MOHealthNet covers 1 out of 5 people, covers 48% of children, and pays for 2/3 of nursing home care. The majority of Medicaid is funded through the federal government.


