LESSONS FROM THE MOUNT

Part Two Of A Five-Part Devotional

Matthew 7:1-5 (NIV)

"Do not judge other people. Then you will not be judged. You will be judged in the same way you judge others. You will be measured in the same way you measure others. You look at the bit of sawdust in your friend's eye. But you pay no attention to the piece of wood in your own eye. How can you say to your friend, 'Let me take the bit of sawdust out of your eye'? How can you say this while there is a piece of wood in your own eye? You pretender! First take the piece of wood out of your own eye. Then you will be able to see clearly to take the bit of sawdust out of your friend's eye."

We all know what it's like to be misjudged. And truth be told, we've probably misjudged a few people ourselves. We live in a world full of judgment, and it was no different in Jesus' day.

In what might be the most quoted section of the "Sermon on the Mount," Jesus warns us to avoid the temptation of focusing on everyone else's shortcomings and messes. Instead, we should concentrate on our own issues, because Lord knows we have plenty of them.

One of the things that is fascinating about this section of the sermon is Jesus' passion about this topic. He calls people who are quick to judge others, "pretenders" or "Hypocrite!" This is one of those occasions where we should pause and look intently to catch the significance of what he's saying.

What he's getting at is that we all have problems in our lives – we're all broken in some way, and we mess up. But I'm not responsible for someone else mess, I'm only responsible for my own, and if I'm going to focus on anybody's problems, they should be my own. Unfortunately, I tend to downplay my issues until I'm convinced that they are not as big as they really are. So it's time to take a

closer look at ourselves and stop looking at others.

To be clear, Jesus isn't saying that we should never try to help others. Not at all. (If your friend has broccoli in her teeth, let her know!) But we should never put other people down. Paul said it this way; we should help people "with gentleness." In other words, lift them up.

So let's get practical. Have you been focusing a little too much on someone else's mess? Have you lost sight of the work that Jesus is doing in you? Today, choose to extend grace rather than judgement to everyone you meet.

I'm willing to bet that is what you would want others to do for you.


