HEALTH FACTS

Clean Out Your Medicine Cabinet

Did you know there is a "National Clean Out Your Medicine Cabinet Day"? It occurs annually on the third Friday in April. The goal is to raise awareness and rid homes of unused or expired prescription and over-the-counter medication that may be sitting in medicine cabinets, nightstands, or kitchen cabinets.

Check the bottles for expired dates. Many medications lose their effectiveness after the expiration date, and some may even become toxic. Discard any prescriptions that are more than one year old. The best way to discard meds is the take them to a local DEA approved center. Our local center is the Boonville Police Department and/or the Boonville Fire Department. Both will be receiving medication April 30th, 2022, from 10am to 2pm.
