HEALTH FACTS

HEART ATTACK

A heart attack generally causes chest pain for more than 15 minutes. This chest pain is a pressure or tightness or a squeezing or aching sensation in the center of the chest. Pain can spread to the left shoulder, arm, back, neck, jaw, teeth, and even upper abdomen. Other symptoms are nausea, indigestion, heartburn, difficulty breathing, lightheadedness, dizziness, fainting, and sweating.

Don't ignore these symptoms. If it is you, have someone drive you to the nearest health center or call 911. If it is happening to your companion, stay calm and call 911. An aspirin can be chewed while waiting, if not contraindicated. It could reduce heart damage by keeping the blood from clotting. Also, nitroglycerin tablets, previous prescribed, can be taken.

Should the companion become unconscious and stop breathing, CPR will be needed. Push hard and fast on the center of the person's chest in a fairly rapid rhythm, about 100-120 times per minute. If an AED (automated external defibrillator) is available, follow the device instructions for using it. Our church is blessed to have an AED located on the downstairs wall to the right of the women's bathroom door.
